Acting is like magic because you get to become someone else for a little while. You can be a hero, a villain, or even an animal!

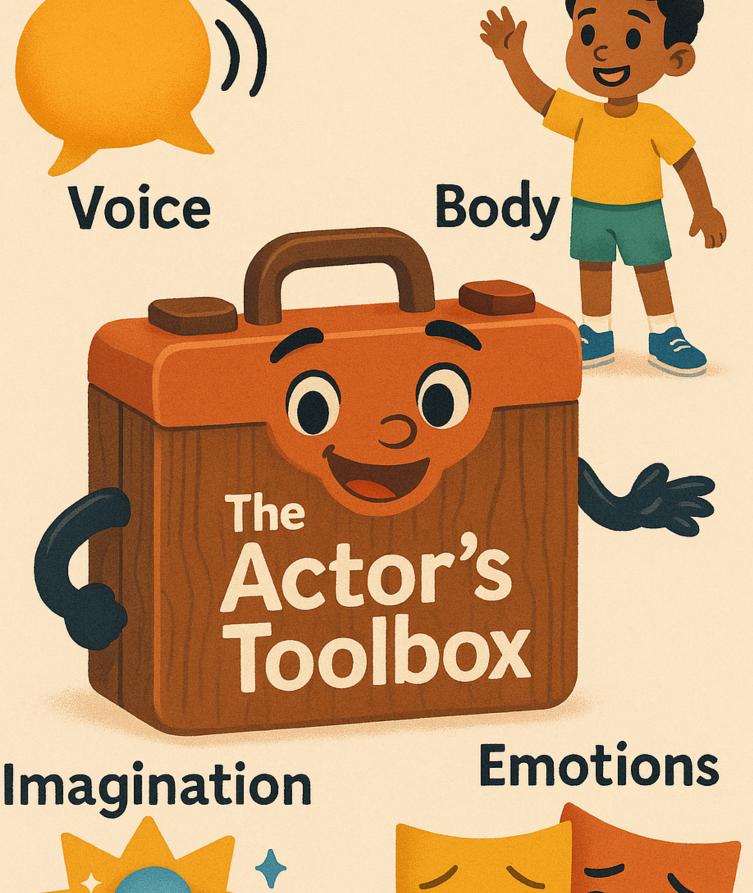
Let's dive into the world of acting and learn how it works!
